The pairs of colors whose names are listed below in red should be combined in the needle to produce a shaded effect. To combine the first pair, for example, take one strand of blue green and place it with one strand of grey blue.

Thread everything into the needle at the same time.

## Use the following combined colors for Half Cross Stitch.

- ♥ — 1 strand of Blue Green and 1 strand of Grey Blue
- ⊗ — 1 strand of Grey Blue and 1 strand of Blue Purple
- ω — 1 strand of Tan and 1 strand of Taupe
- U — 1 strand of Dk. Gold and 1 strand of Dk. Taupe
- ⊗ — 2 strands of Dk. Grey and 1 strand of Black

## Use two strands of the following colors for Cross Stitch.

- — Dusty Peach
- ▲ — Orange
- ♥ — Dk. Orange
- & — Green
- ▲ — Blue Green
- ★ — Dk. Green
- H — Lt. Blue
- Σ — Cream

- ∞ — Dk. Gold

- Σ — Dk. Taupe
